

Project „ESCO Capacity Building Service No. 7: technical ESCO Workshops for IPMVP and IEEFP”

Period: 2014 (6 months)

Summary

The main objectives of the project were the design of a programme for the conduct of a series of technical and non-technical workshops for ESCO stakeholders. Energy Consulting was responsible for technical workshops and training for engineers and technical experts with the following main focus:

- International Performance Measurement and Verification Protocol (IPMVP)
- International Energy Efficiency Financing Protocol (IEEFP)

The technical workshops were carried out according to the agreed programme and scheduled in Kingston and Montego Bay mid of September. In addition, another “advanced general session” was scheduled in Kingston to conclude the series. Additional support was provided by Energy Consulting in preparation and performing this advanced “interactive” general session with following focus:

- Deep dive on IPMVP (case study course work with guideline and calculation examples)

The evaluation and preparation of a report on the implementation of the workshop programme was supported, e.g. with recommendations for further training, model and pilot project development issues and with evaluation of questionnaires filled out by the participants and of the direct feedback and insights gained throughout the workshops.

Main results

- workshop programme and related training material (IPMVP, IEEFP) developed
- two technical workshops executed, non-technical workshops/advanced interactive session supported
- Workshops evaluated, final report with recommendations for further training, model and pilot project development issues
